APPLICATION PROCESS

Application: Complete the one-page application detailing the event or activity purpose with estimated total costs and grant request not to exceed \$500. Costs will be paid directly to vendors detailed in the budget proposal.

Post-Event Evaluation: Applicants will be provided an event report template to submit for post-event evaluation and data collection. This information is important in continuing with the community projects. By submitting an application, you agree to complete and return the post-event evaluation or you will no longer be eligible for additional project funding for the remainder of the year.
